Cobotic: Rollout of the Nexaro Robot Vacuum Cleaner to Customers

This year, 160 Nexaro robot vacuum cleaners will start working for our customers. The first vacuums will be installed at a customer's early next year by Regional Manager Raphael Blank and Technical Manager Marc Schroeder from our Wuppertal branch, which has already planned the rollout of 80 Nexaro vacuum robots to customers over the next few weeks. The other Vebego companies in Europe will also be rolling out the Nexaro to their customers.

"We are delighted that the robots have proved so popular with both our customers and our staff. Offices and open spaces, especially, are often ideal areas for using vacuum robots thanks to the freedom of movement they offer. The robots are used mainly in circulation areas because that's where we see the greatest added value," says Blank.

Robot helps cleaning staff with the laborious chore of floor cleaning

Vebego will be continuing to develop the partnership we entered into with Nexaro in 2018 because we understand the usefulness of the Cobotic approach taken by Nexaro. Cobotic describes the collaboration between human being and robot. The Nexaro robots assist the cleaning staff by relieving them of heavy job of floor cleaning. This leaves staff free to concentrate on performing more challenging tasks. This guarantees a consistently high standard of cleaning and optimises processes.
